### **Student Absences**

Thank you to all of our families for either phoning in or e-mailing us with student absences.

As we continue to work to ensure the safety of our students at Duffield School, it is so important that we are aware when your child is absent from school. ## **Morning Student Drop Off**

We appreciate your continued support waiting to drop students off in the morning. Teachers are not available to supervise students until 7:40 AM. This allows us to follow the government restrictions around cohorting due to COVID-19. With warmer temperatures, we will be keeping the doors to the school locked until 7:40 AM when supervision begins. Students who arrive before this time will need to wait outside until the morning bell rings to enter the school.

### Dress for the weather

With the warmer weather, students are still required to dress for the current weather. In order to enjoy outdoor activities such as recess and physical education classes, students will need to dress appropriately for weather conditions. "There is no such thing as a child who hates to read; there are only children who have not found the right book". "Frank Serafini


Therefore, I challenge you to find the right book with your child this summer! How to do this? The confidence that comes with feeling like a successful reader who has the freedom to read whatever they choose, cannot be underestimated!

#### Summer Reading Challenge:

- Read a new book from your favourite author
- Read one new book every week
- Join or create your own book club
- Read one book that's related to your favourite subject in school
- Read an autobiography or a biography
- Read a book that takes place in another world
- Read a book recommended by your best friend
- Pick a random book to read from the library
- Read a book series
- Read a book your teacher recommends
- Read your parent's favourite children's book
- Read a book by an author who has the same initials as you do
- Read a book that is also a movie.
- Read a play and act out your favourite scene with your family.
- Read a book that was published the year you were born.
- Reread your favourite book of all time.
