## **Online Registration/Verification for 2021-2022**

Just a reminder that all students from Early Education (3-4 Year Program) to Grade 12 will be able to either **register (new students)** or verify their **existing data (returning students)** online, beginning **February 8, 2021**.

To ensure that your child receives a bus pass prior to the start of the next school year, parents/ guardians are required to complete registration by **4:30pm on March 25, 2021**. This deadline will facilitate the routing of buses, bus pass production and data verification before the summer break while schools are still operating.
