## **PSD COVID PROTOCOLS**

#### PSD's Guidance for School Re-Entry-COVID protocols Of particular note:

**General Building Safety** - continued enhanced cleaning and disinfecting, promotion of healthy hygiene practices, and increased circulation of outdoor air as much as possible.

**Responding to Illness** - Staff or students with COVID-19 symptoms (new or worsening and not related to other known causes), will be required to isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms, or until they receive a negative COVID-19 test result, as per provincial guidelines. Students or staff who develop symptoms while at school will be sent home and be required to isolate, as per AHS guidelines. Please ensure that you are accessing the daily AHS Screening tool before you send your children to school.

**Masks** - Masks are strongly recommended for all students and staff in all common areas and in situations where 2 metres of distance cannot be maintained. As per the Alberta Health Services (AHS) directive, masks will be required for all students (regardless of age or grade) while on a school bus.

**Cohorts** - Where practical, PSD schools will have students work in a limited number of cohorts.

**Close Contacts** - As per AHS guidelines, close contacts of a positive case will not be required to isolate for 14-days as per provincial guidelines on self-isolation.

**Visitors** - As COVID continues to be prevalent in our province, all visitors will be asked to come to the office, wearing a mask. Unfortunately, we are unable to have parent volunteers in our classrooms at this time.

## **Duffield Code of Conduct**

I have attached the Duffield Code of Conduct so that you can make yourself aware of our hopes and expectations for all of our students. Of particular note will be a change in our cell phone policy. I wanted to share with you the cell phone policy that our staff will be reinforcing in that cell phones will remain in lockers or backpacks throughout the school day. We know that cell phones can be incredibly distracting in the learning environment and we want our students to be actively engaged in their learning, without the disruption of text messages and snapchat interactions. While I know that this will be a shift for our students, I believe that this will be a new opportunity to enjoy one another's company during breaks and to focus on social media outside of school hours. We will, of course, give students an opportunity to check phones before they go outside for breaks but if you need to contact your child, please call the office and we will have a message delivered.

We hope that students will adapt easily to this new cell phone policy but if they forget to put cell phones in their lockers, a warning will be given. If a student chooses not to listen to the adults in charge, the cell phone will be brought down to the office and it will be stored in a locked cabinet, our "cell phone hotel" until the end of the day. Your support in reinforcing limited cell phone use will be greatly appreciated!

#### VIRTUAL MEET THE TEACHER

Unfortunately, we are unable to have visitors in our school at this time because of the PSD COVID restrictions. Duffield School has been chosen as a COVID Vaccination Clinic location for students who would like to be vaccinated. We will be sending letters and consent forms home to parents who have children over the age of 12. If you are interested in having your child vaccinated, the consent can be returned and I will forward the

information to the AHS health nurses. If you have any questions about this vaccination clinic, please feel free to reach out. Please know that this vaccination is a completely voluntary service.

#### SCHOOL COUNCIL/FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE
