COVID Protocols	<ul> <li>As our province has moved into Step 2 of its reopening, with lessening of COVID restrictions, we are embracing a time of making decisions that are best for individuals. We have staff and students who are still most comfortable wearing masks but we also have individuals who have chosen to leave masks at home at this time. We respect all of the decisions made by families and students and approach this phase with some optimism!</li> <li>We will no longer require cohorting of students in Kindergarten-Grade 6 and therefore our recesses will move to unrestricted areas.</li> <li>The removal of cross-cohorting restrictions on buses means that our two classes of students will now be able to ride on the same bus to the Tri-Leisure for Play Parkland!</li> </ul>
	We will continue to focus on sanitization to prevent illness but we do ask families to continue to keep children home if they are not well.
