Welcome Back!




Thank you to our staff and I look forward to connecting with all of our students and families as we enjoy the first day of school!

Cell Phone and Mobile Technology Use in Schools

You may be aware that in June 2024 the Minister of Education, Dr. Demetrios Nicolaides issued the Ministerial Order on Standards for the Use of Personal Mobile Devices and Social Media in Schools. In brief, the order prohibits the use of mobile devices including cell phones, personal computers, tablets, and smartwatches (and other similar devices) during instructional (classroom) time and prohibits access of social media platforms using school networks and devices. The order allows for the use of these devices for medical reasons or to support special learning needs at the discretion of the principal.

At Duffield, we have current procedures related to mobile devices and have updated these to align both with the Ministerial Order and our neighboring K-9 PSD schools.

The <u>Duffield Code of Conduct</u> can be viewed in the attached link and it highlights the Cell Phone Policy as well as all of our school expectations!!

Please note that even with the updated cell phone policy for Duffield School, families are always encouraged to call the school in the event they need to speak to their child and students will have access to the office phone if necessary. Our secretaries will be happy to pass on any messages you may have.

Thank you for reviewing this policy with your child and supporting these adjustments. Additional information for parents regarding these changes may be found in <u>this letter</u> from the Minister of Education. The letter includes informative research pertaining to student focus and mental well-being regarding mobile devices and social media use in schools.


Out of School Care


