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### Old Business

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#### Movie Subscription Renewal

School staff and DPAC members felt it was a great resource that could be utilized going forward. There is no additional cost now that it is in more classrooms either, making it a

### **Mom's Pantry Update (Jessica Lutz)**

- Shelby will follow up to see if the AGLC funds would cover the PORTABLE soccer nets. The estimate Mrs. Lovsund received so far is approx. \$5000. Mrs. Lovsund has received an approx. estimate for the regular nets between \$1200-1500. The nets still need to be measured and this will be followed up in the new year.

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## **New Business – Fundraising Priorities**

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### **Additional requests from the School**

- There are a few new Jr High Options happening and some equipment needs. The “Business of Beauty” is temporarily going to borrow the mannequin wigs from Copperhaven to use and see if it would be a beneficial investment going forward. There was a lot of interest in the option from students. Mrs. Lovsund will get prices and DPAC will vote in January.
- Mr. Kelher is going to be running an Outdoor Education option. Archery, Hunting and other aspects may be covered. Mrs. Lovsund may purchase some materials such as compasses in order for the option to get started and then DPAC may be able to

reimburse.

- Speech to Text microphones were discussed. These are approx. \$400 a piece and there is a need for at least 6 currently. The school may purchase a few so students have access to them now and DPAC will look into whether AGLC funds can be used for this.
- The birdhouse project by Dave Maycher was discussed for happening in May-June for a possible Father's Day project with students throughout the school. Laurel Verlinde will contact him and share details for the next meeting.

#### **Staff Dinner for Christmas Concert Night**

- DPAC would like to put on a Staff Supper on the Christmas Concert night. Michelle will look into getting a Perfect Potluck Sign Up started for parents/ community to sign up for.

#### **Ideas for getting more Volunteers**

- There is currently a survey that went out to parents and families asking interested people to share contact information for future volunteer opportunities. Currently there are 24 people, which is a wonderful start. DPAC is hoping to find more people to volunteer in order to be able to create more opportunities for the school community and families to gather. Some ideas if more families/ volunteers are available include, Family Dances, Treat Days with concession items and Turkey Bingo. Mrs. Lovsund will look into how DPAC can share possible Google Doc sign up sheets with parents/ community members through the school so more people are aware of opportunities.
