Cell Phone and Mobile Technology Use in Schools

A reminder that Cell Phones and Mobile Technology use in schools are still under the direction of the mandate from June 2024 when the Ministerial Order was issued.

To summarize the order: prohibits the use of mobile devices including cell phones, personal computers, tablets, and smartwatches (and other similar devices) during instructional (classroom) time and prohibits access of social media platforms using school networks and devices. The order allows for the use of these devices for medical reasons at the discretion of the Principal.

As such - cell phones and other mobile devices are not allowed at Duffield School. Please follow the school Code of Conduct for full instructions
